FACULTY

Ellen Cohn, PhD, CCC-SLP, formerly a professor in the Department of Communication Science and Disorders at the University of Pittsburgh, is now Adjunct Professor, Department of Communication and Rhetoric at the University of Pittsburgh and University of Maryland Global Campus. She is an ASHA Fellow and presents on telepractice at national and regional conferences. Cohn teaches courses in cleft palate/craniofacial disorders, professional issues, culture, diversity and health care, and rhetoric and communication. She has co-authored books on tele-AAC, telerehabilitation, communication science and disorders (a casebook),



videofluoroscopy/ cleft palate, diversity in higher education, and communication. She has also co-authored two programs at the University of Pittsburgh's School of Law: a Certificate Program in Disability Law, and the first MSL with a Concentration in Disability Law. She is a past investigator for a Department of Education – National Institute on Disability and Rehabilitation Research, Rehabilitation Engineering Research Center on Telerehabilitation. Cohn has been the founding editor of the *International Journal of Telerehabilitation* since 2008 and was the founding coordinator of ASHA's SIG 18 (Telepractice). She served on the board of directors of the American Telemedicine Association (ATA) and as chair of the ATA Telerehabilitation SIG. Cohn served as an associate dean in the School of Health and Rehabilitation for 8 years, and for 4 years as interim program director of the multi-disciplinary undergraduate program in Rehabilitation Science.
